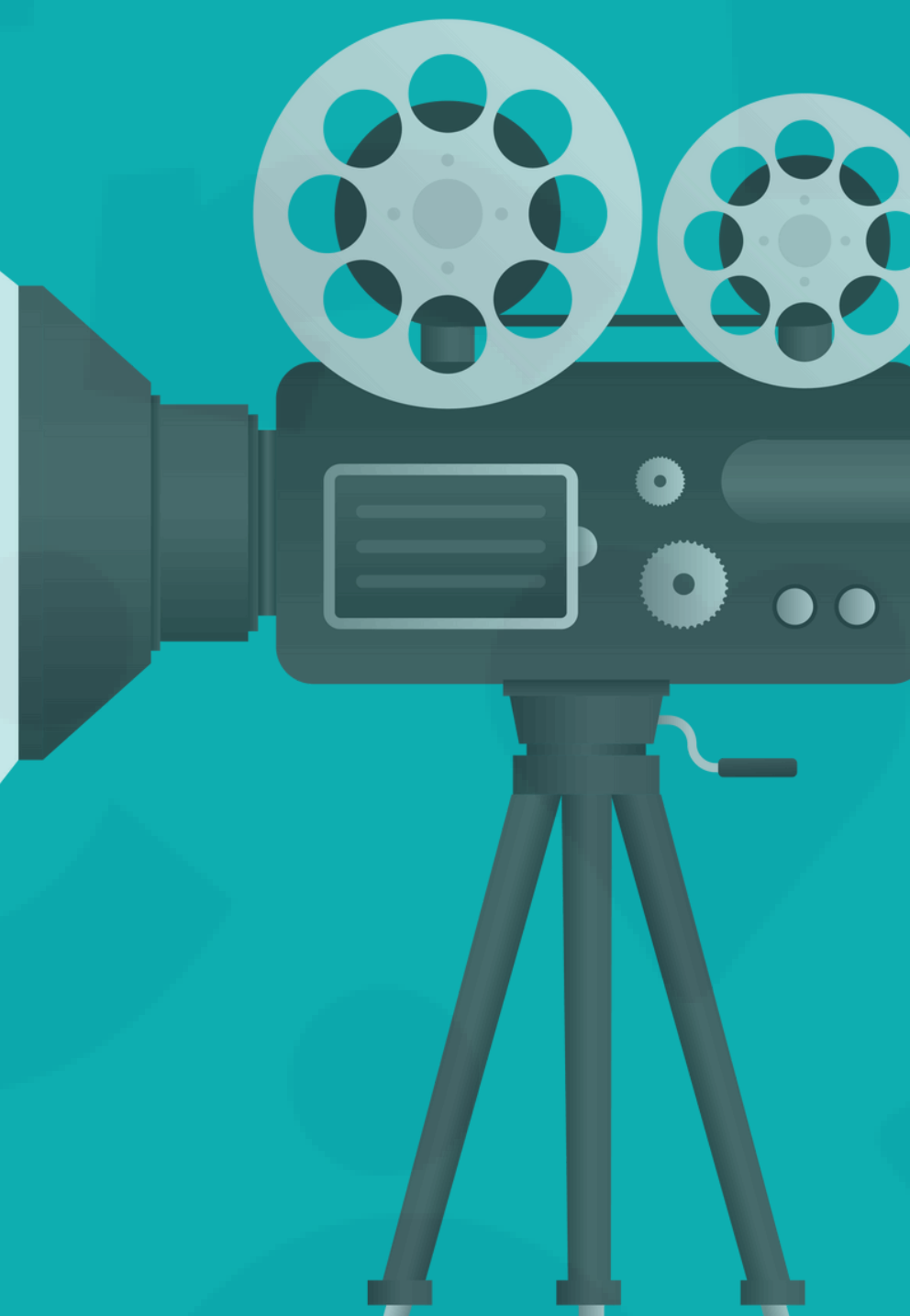


STORY-TELLING FOR TOGETHERNESS
